COMMON SENSE RULES AND A SUPPLEMENT

NATURE CAMPING CARD

Anyone who camps with us must have a valid membership of the "De Groene Koepel" foundation. This is available at reception for €15.95, with a Green Booklet for €19.95.

ARRIVAL DEPARTURE

Please report to reception upon arrival. This also applies to visitors. Visitors must pay €1.50 per person.

You are welcome at the site from 2:00 PM.

On the day of departure you must leave the place before 12:00. If you leave after 12:00, we will charge half a day rate.

ADMISSION

Daphne and Mike (the managers) decide on admission to the site, taking into account the provisions of these "regulations". We are entitled at all times to deny campers their stay if they do not comply with the rules or our instructions.

CARS

It is not allowed to park your car on your camping pitch. Of course you can drive your car to the place to load/unload. There is ample parking outside the camping area.

CLEANLINESS

- Keep the area tidy! This applies to your location as well as the paths and the sanitary building.
 - Leave your camping pitch in the condition you found it when you started using it.--
- There are containers at the entrance for paper, glass and residual waste. Make use of these too! Due to the risk of clogging, do not flush sanitary towels down the toilets, but place them in the appropriate hygiene containers.-
- Before washing dishes, please empty the plates and pans into the rubbish bin, this will prevent the sink in the washing up area from clogging.

WE REALLY DON'T WANT TO SEE THIS:

- No digging is allowed on the site, not even for so-called rain gutters.
- Wash your car or caravan in the car wash, not on our site.
- Open fire is not allowed on site! Not even in a fire bowl, fire basket or BBQ. (Barbecuing is allowed, using coals and firelighters, unless otherwise indicated.)

CAMPFIRE

Once a week (usually on Saturdays) you can make a campfire in the campfire pit on the large field. An adult must be present at all times while lighting and burning the campfire. We also like to see a bucket of water next to it. As mentioned in the previous point, it is absolutely not permitted to light a fire on the camping site, not even in a barbecue or so-called fire basket.

SOUND

It must be quiet between 10 p.m. and 7 a.m. Don't play your radio too loudly during the day and if you are not skilled at playing the musical instrument you brought with you, feel free to leave it in the box \odot

PETS

Pets are only allowed on a short leash. If your dog suddenly can't hold it anymore, clean it up.

VISITORS

Nice when you have visitors, but please let us know. We always want to know who is walking around our property. We will let you know whether, given the crowds on the site, it is okay to receive visitors. Visitors must pay €1.50.

PITCHES WITH ELECTRICITY

The electrical pitches are fused at 6 amps, so approximately 1250 watts. When using a hairdryer, Senseo, tanning bed or radiant heaters, the electricity in your area will fail. We will be happy to sort this out for you, provided we are present on the campsite.

SANITARY BUILDING

Children under the age of 6 are only allowed in the sanitary building under supervision. During high season the toilet building is closed for cleaning between approximately 12:00 noon and 1:00 pm.

The showers run for 5 minutes and are free, but... Be economical with energy.
